101 EQUIPER	<p><u>5T Worldview</u> I think about 5T's in all my interactions with non-Christians and I help my small group members do the same. The fields are ripe for harvest!</p>	<p><u>I am an Evangelism Leader</u> I help my small group members successfully take steps of faith in relational evangelism. I help them move through their fears and barriers to evangelism. (2 Tim 2:2)</p>	<p><u>5T Mobilizer</u> I help my SG (or another structure) grow in 5T 101 Relational Evangelism.</p>	<p><u>5T Interpreter</u> I am good at using discipleship cycles for each threshold. I debrief regularly with my small group and interpret what God might be doing.</p>
201 ARTISAN	<p><u>Threshold My Ministry**</u> I feel empowered to make chapter changes so that non-Christians feel welcomed into all we do. I can threshold an event to help non-Christians grow toward Jesus.</p>	<p><u>5T Trainer</u> I train people in my ministry to do 201 Relational Evangelism. I'm good at helping people make decisions (cross from 4th to 5th threshold). I coach new believers to tell their story and begin movements.</p>	<p><u>Ministry Artisan</u> Ministry is my canvas. Structures can and should be molded to help non-Christians grow through 5T. I use flexible thinking to keep improving structures.</p>	<p><u>Plant Using 2+</u> I know how to discern when someone else's network is ripe for planting a SG or GIG. I learn from my mistakes and try again.</p>

I adjust based on context.</p>	<p>SPIRITUAL AUTHORITY I am growing in my spiritual authority. I cross-cultures and I understand different niche communities on campus.</p>	<p>Let me be Jew to the Jews and Greek to the Greeks. (PRAY 1 COR 9:20-22)</p>
